

## Rooftop Paver Maintenance

Rooftop pavers are designed to be maintenance free. However, should it become necessary to clean the pavers, the following precautions should be taken:

- 1. Power sprayers should be avoided as it is possible to damage the pavers if excessive pressure is used in a concentrated area.
- 2. Concrete cleaning agents can be used as long as they are approved by the membrane manufacture. Belgard Commercial assumes no responsibility for damage caused to the pavers or membrane as a result of cleaners used.
- 3. Do not use de-icing agents including but not limited to Ammonium Nitrate, Ammonium Sulfate, Sodium Chloride (salt) and Calcium Chloride; these agents can be destructive and cause damage to pavers.

When cleaning the surface of pavers, the following actions should be taken:

- 1. Sweep the pavers clean of any debris
- 2. If using a cleaning agent, follow directions provided by cleaner manufacture
  - a. Test in a small area to see if the desired results are attained
- 3. Wet down the entire surface and once again sweep the pavers clear of any debris
- 4. Clean surface of paver using a broom or brush
- 5. Once cleaned, rinse the pavers completely to avoid staining
- 6. If rinse water is allowed to pool on pavers, secondary efflorescence can occur
